COVID 19 UPDATES FROM LCA QLD Summary of current restrictions for Places of Worship

- Indoor and outdoor venues/spaces — **one person per 2 square metres**.
- Funerals and weddings — one person per 2 square metres (capped at 200 people).
- Physical distancing is to be observed *to the extent possible*. Defined social groups or family groups may sit together. The entire congregation cannot be deemed a single social group.
- Face masks are recommended if physical distancing is not possible.
- Contact information for attendees must be recorded and stored for a minimum of 30 days and for no longer than 56 days.
- Food and drink may be served, but under the [Retail Food Services Industry COVID Safe Plan](#) or the [COVID Safe Checklist: Dining and drinking. Training](#) is mandatory for servers. Self-service of food and buffets are not permitted.
- Small group gatherings in homes — up to 50 people.
- Private gatherings in public outdoor spaces — up to 100 people.
- Hall hirer — numbers dependent on the relevant Industry Plan or Checklist applicable to the hirer's activities.
- Events — 1500 people permitted at outdoor events with a COVID Safe Event Checklist. Larger events require a COVID Safe Plan.
- If food or drink is served, contact information must be kept electronically. The Qld Government App Check in Qld is a suitable way to manage this
